JOB DESCRIPTION

Part-time Firefighter/EMT-B (Reservist)

Description

The City of Sansom Park Fire Department is currently accepting applications for Firefighter / EMT-B (Reservist) to fill part-time staffing positions to be added to increase staffing levels from 2 to 3 per shift. These positions will work a 12 hour shift with a variable pay range depending on day or night shift and position.

General Job Duties

- Respond to fire, rescue, medical, hazardous material calls and other emergency and non-emergency calls in a timely and efficient manner.
- Perform fire suppression functions, including firefighting, rescue, deploying fire hose, ventilating roofs and performing salvage and overhaul.
- Perform Pre-Planning
- Administer emergency medical services to injured persons as a first responder.
- Perform operational readiness evaluation on the fire apparatus and equipment to ensure it is fully prepared and functional at all times.
- Inventories equipment, tools, PPE, SCBA and radios upon reporting to duty.
- Prepare and submit fire reports, EMS reports, daily and weekly maintenance check reports.
- Participate in fire and EMS training.
- Study street maps and learn district.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Fire Chief or other officer of the department.

Requirements – Minimum Qualifications

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Valid Texas Class B Exempt License (or obtained within 6 months)
- Current TCFP Basic Firefighter
- Current DSHS EMT-B
- NIMS 100,200,700 and 800 (or obtained within 6 months)
- Courage to be Safe

Preferred Qualifications

- TCFP Driver Operator
- TCFP Haz-Mat Tech
- TCFP Fire Officer

Hiring Process

- Applications are being accepted now. Applications may be returned in person, email or regular mail.
- A hiring list will be established with successful candidates remaining on the list for 12 months.
- Applications will be reviewed and potential candidates will receive an invitation by email with further instructions.
- If candidates currently work at another fire department, a physical ability test will be waived. If candidates do not currently work for another agency, a PAT will be assigned.
- Prospective applicants will then be ranked and placed upon the eligibility list and conditional offers will be made when positions become available.
