RESOLUTION NO. 984-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANSOM PARK, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MAY 7, 2016 GENERAL ELECTION TO ELECT THE OFFICES OF MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL PLACE 1, AND CITY COUNCIL PLACE 2 AND A SPECIAL ELECTION ON A REFERENDUM TO DETERMINE THE CONTINUATION OF THE CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT SALES TAX FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY (20) YEARS TO BE HELD ON MAY 7, 2016; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Sansom Park (the “City”) is a general law type A city, pursuant to the Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2016, the City’s General and Special Election was held in accordance with the Election Code for the purpose of electing Office of Mayor, City Council members Places 1 and 2 and on a Referendum to determine the continuation of the Crime Control and Prevention District Sales Tax for a period of Twenty (20) years; and

WHEREAS, state law requires that the governing body of the City of Sansom Park canvass all elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANSOM PARK, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.
