CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Jim Barnett, Jr. called regular meeting to order at 6:00 pm. A quorum is present of the City Council. Member Willie Roach was absent.

CITY BUSINESS

1. Conduct the Official Canvass of the Election Returns for the General Election Office of Mayor, City Council Place 1 and City Council Place 2 and Special Election on a referendum to determine the continuation of the Crime Control and Prevention District Sales Tax for a period of twenty (20) years; held May 7, 2016 in the City of Sansom Park, Texas. Mayor Barnett, Jr. presented the results of the General and Special Elections held on May 7, 2016.

2. Discuss and consider adoption of Resolution 984-16, a resolution of the City Council of the City of Sansom Park, Texas, canvassing and declaring the results of the May 7, 2016 General Election for Office of Mayor, City Council Place 1 and City Council Place 2 to elect Municipal Officers and Special Election on a referendum to determine the continuation of the Crime Control and Prevention District Sales Tax for a period of twenty (20) years, and Mayor Barnett, Jr. to issue the Certificates of Election. Member Barnett, Sr. made a motion to adopt Resolution 984-16, second by Mayor Pro-Tem Crystal Harris. Council voted unanimously to adopt Resolution 984-16, a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Sansom Park, Texas, canvassing and declaring the results of the May 7, 2016 General Election for Office of Mayor, City Council Place 1 and City Council Place 2 to elect Municipal Officers and Special Election on a referendum to determine the continuation of the Crime Control and Prevention District Sales Tax for a period of twenty (20) years. Motion carried 4-0.
