RESOLUTION NO. 1005-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANSOM PARK, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MAY 6, 2017 GENERAL ELECTION TO ELECT THE OFFICES OF CITY COUNCIL PLACE 3, CITY COUNCIL PLACE 4, CITY COUNCIL PLACE 5 AND A SPECIAL ELECTION ON A REFERENDUM TO DETERMINE THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF SANSOM PARK, TEXAS AT THE RATE OF ONE-FOURTH (1/4) OF ONE PERCENT (1%) TO CONTINUE PROVIDING REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS FOR A PERIOD OF FOUR (4) YEARS TO BE HELD ON MAY 6, 2017; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Sansom Park (the “City”) is a general law type A city, pursuant to the Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2017, the City’s General and Special Election was held in accordance with the Election Code for the purpose of electing City Council members Places 3, 4 and 5 and on a Referendum to determine the reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Sansom Park, Texas at the rate of one-fourth (1/4) of one percent (1%) to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets for a period of four (4) years; and

WHEREAS, state law requires that the governing body of the City of Sansom Park canvass all elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANSOM PARK, TEXAS:
