WHEREAS, the City of Sansom Park is a Type A General Law Municipality located in Tarrant County Texas, created in accordance with provisions of the Texas Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sansom Park, Texas is a general law municipality empowered under the Texas Local Government Code, Section 51.001, to adopt an ordinance or rule that is for the good government of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sansom Park has determined that it is essential to have a Master Fee Schedule to provide efficiency and uniformity in establishing and adjusting the fees charged by the City of Sansom Park as cited throughout the City of Sansom Park Code of Ordinances into one abbreviated schedule; and

WHEREAS, the fees set forth in the Master Fee Schedule shall supersede any fee established elsewhere in the City's Code of Ordinances for the same charge. If a fee is set forth elsewhere in the City of Sansom Park's Code of Ordinances or adopted ordinances and there is no corresponding fee set forth in the attached Master Fee Schedule, the fee set forth elsewhere in the Code of Ordinances or adopted ordinance shall control, until such time as a fee for the same charge is established in the Master Fee Schedule.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANSOM PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

That the attached "Exhibit A" shall be the Master Fee Schedule for the City of Sansom Park, Texas.

**SECTION II.
SEVERABILITY**

That it is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of the Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this Ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such invalid or unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

**SECTION III
REPEALING CLAUSE**

This ordinance repeals ordinances and any provisions of all other ordinances in conflict herewith.


**SECTION IV
